We are aware of the ongoing issues with PCSE and have been feeding this back to NHS England. We have highlighted about the mailbox being full and therefore not accepting pension submissions. The inbox has now been expanded with people monitoring this to ensure that this issue does not arise again. NHSE have agreed that there will be a grace period to send in these submissions. We are unsure of how many people have been unable to submit, and how many were sent after the deadline, but NHS England have agreed to a grace period so doctors should send in their forms as soon as possible in which case they will not lose out.
