You will be aware of the difficulties GP Trainees are experiencing with regard to the Performers List application process.



Subject: RE: URGENT - Further Extension of Grace Period for GP Trainees?

Dear Linda and Dean

I have tried to copy in everyone who has contacted about this today , but please share as needed

I am very sorry that this situation has occurred .

I believe it is anticipated that inclusions will be complete before the end of the extended grace period , however in view of the anxiety and concern being raised at the impending end of the extended grace period and to allow practices to continue to arrange surgeries for their GP registrars interim I can advise that NHS England Yorkshire and Humber have adopted the following position.

This is as follows :

GP Trainee joining the NPI

We are aware, there is a grace period of 3 months to allow for administration of a trainees application to the NPL. During these 3 months, a trainee may perform primary medical services, despite not being included in that list.

The legislation states:-

(5) A GP Registrar, who has applied in accordance with these Regulations to the Board for inclusion in the medical performers list, may perform primary medical services, despite not being included in that list, until the first of the following arises—

(a) the date on which the Board notifies that GP Registrar of its decision on the application for inclusion; or (b) the end of a period of 3 months, starting with the date on which that GP Registrar begins a foundation training scheme.

NHS England are aware there has been a significant delay with GP Registrars applications and through no fault of their own the 3 month grace period has lapsed. We can confirm that if you have

a) Applied in accordance with the regulations and

b) Co-operated with Capita/FHS for the submission of any outstanding aspects of the application

NHS England Yorkshire and the Humber local office will agree you to performing primary medical services, despite not being included in the list, as you have been confirmed by Health Education England as GP registrar.

Your indemnity provider must confirm to your employer that they will provide the appropriate level of indemnity prior to your continued working

In the meantime you must progress your application and continue to co-operate with Capita/FHS for the submission of any outstanding aspects of the application

I am sure all the trainees will have complied with all requests made of them from Capita – I would be grateful if you could pass my apologies on to them for any confusion or distress which has arisen from this issue

Any trainee who is having any issues can contact me directly and I will try to assist them
